To Enroll in the Tennessee School of Ministry (TSOM):

1. Complete an enrollment form and pay a one-time fee of \$25.00 (per level) and a fee of \$50.00 per course enrollment. (i.e., if you are enrolling for the first time in Level I (Certified) you would pay a total of \$75.00. If you are enrolling for a second course in Level I (Certified) you would pay a total of \$50.00.) Duplicate form as needed.
2. Return form and fees to TSOM.

Each course is \$50.00. There is a one-time charge of \$25.00 as follows:

Level I (Certified)	- \$25.00
Level II (Licensed)	- \$25.00
Level III (Ordained)	- \$25.00

**Funds are not refundable. Credit may be received and applied for up to 1 year toward another course. Cancellation notice must be received one week prior to class commencement (except for emergency absences). TSOM must be notified by email/written request for transfer of funds from one class to another.*

Prior to Attending Class:

2. **Read the entire textbook.**
3. **Complete Class Text Overview.** Please insert **type written** answers on the Text Overview. Do not attach a separate sheet. Text Overview must be turned in at the beginning of the Friday night class.
4. Make a **copy** of your completed Text Overview to keep and use during class.

Bring to Class:

Bring notepaper, pen, Bible, textbook and a **copy** of your completed **type written** Text Overview for that course to class.
